
Description


The Invesco BulletShares® USD High Yield Corporate Bond 2027 Index provides exposure to a diversified basket of US dollar-denominated, high yield corporate bonds, all with a maturity – or, in some cases, effective maturity – of 2027. The Index combines the precise maturity exposure of an individual bond with the diversification benefits of a broad basket of securities, and is expected to have a return profile similar to a held-to-maturity bond.

Methodology highlights

The Invesco BulletShares® USD High Yield Corporate Bond 2027 Index consists of US dollar-denominated securities of globally domiciled corporate issuers that pay fixed amounts of taxable interest. Bonds must have a maximum credit rating of BB+ (or equivalent) and a minimum average rating of CCC- (or equivalent). Bonds must also have a minimum outstanding par amount of \$200 million to be included.

Any allocation to AAA bonds results from reinvestment of intramonth coupon payments, or matured or called proceeds in US Treasury Bills. Please see the methodology document for more details








